Primary Formal Uniform (Prep-Year 6)

Hair

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair ties and hair bands are to be navy blue, light blue, gold or white. The wearing of novelty clips and hair accessories is unsuitable • Tinting, colouring and dyeing of hair are not permitted in the primary school. • Senior school girls may colour their hair so that it remains natural looking without any bold or unnatural colours or streaks. • Hair which is cut extremely short is not acceptable • Small plaits all over and dreadlocks are not permitted • Girls hair which touches the collar must be tied back • Fringes must be kept out of the eyes 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Head shaving shorter than number 2 and partial head shaving is unsuitable • Small plaits all over and dreadlocks are not permitted • Hair is to be above the shirt collar and out of the eyes • Unkempt hair is unsuitable • Tinting, colouring and dyeing of hair are not permitted in the primary school. • Senior boys may colour their hair so that it remains natural looking without any bold or unnatural colours or streaks. • Boys hair which touches the collar must be tied back • Fringes must be kept out of the eyes

Jewellery

GIRLS	BOYS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sleepers and plain gold or silver studs are the only permissible jewellery (one only in each ear positioned appropriately in the lobe). • Except for a watch and one signet ring, the wearing of all other jewellery, including necklaces is unsuitable • No body studs (including nose piercings) are allowed 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The wearing of earrings is unsuitable. • Except for a watch, the wearing of jewellery is unsuitable • No body studs are allowed

Make-up and Nail Polish

- The wearing of makeup is not permitted. Senior school girls may wear natural looking foundation or powder but this cannot be heavy, unnatural or obvious in appearance.
- Clear nail enamel/polish may be worn however fake nails, French tips or any coloured or glitter nail enamel/polish is unsuitable.
